

Figure G 1. Location of study area (green) and development area (shaded red)






Figure G 3. Wenvoe estate map X, 1762 (William Morrice) with development boundary (red)




Figure G 4. Parish of Sully Tithe Map; 1846




Figure G 5. First Edition Ordnance Survey Map, 1885




Figure G 6. Second Edition Ordnance Survey Map, 1901




Figure G 7. Third Edition Ordnance Survey Map, 1921




Figure G 8. Fourth Edition Ordnance Survey Map, 1938


