Tea-rooms were opened in seaside villages during the 1930s. Many tourists came here to visit the caves in the limestone cliffs of Tresilian Bay near Marcross. According to legend, you could predict how soon you would marry by seeing how far you could throw a pebble into a certain cave. The parents of General Picton, who was killed at Waterloo, were married in one of the caves.
