Electricity Act 1989: Overhead Lines (Exemption)(England and Wales) Regulations 2009

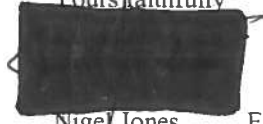
It is proposed to undertake the following work that is considered to be exempted from the Electricity Act 1989 by falling within the Overhead Lines (Exemption)(England and Wales) Regulations 2009:

Particulars of proposed development:

It is necessary to carry out diversionary works at this location as the existing overhead line is affecting the business operation which exists at this location. Our proposal is to divert 2 spans of high voltage overhead line away from the area of the business to avoid any potential issues. The existing design will be replaced partly by and underground section of high voltage cable and a new high voltage overhead span as shown on the enclosed plan. The required wayleave consent has been obtained from the relevant landowner.

The Council is requested to indicate that it has no objection to the work being carried out by returning two copies of this Form with the Certificate completed and signed.
