As you may remember we commented on the application in our letter dated 15th March 2016, and our understanding of the archaeological resource of the area remains unchanged.

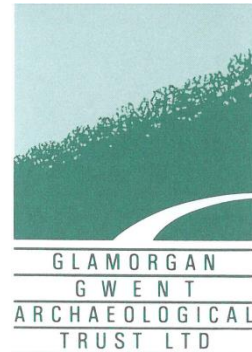
We note the current amendments, but they do not affect any potential impacts on the archaeological resource or relate to any archaeological constraint. As a result, we have no further comment at this time.
