

GENERAL NOTES

No allowance has been made for landscaping (trees, mounds, planting, turf or general reinstatement) & fencing. These should be carried out by others.

If not indicated on this plan, north point must be confirmed prior to installation to ensure that slides do not face due south.

Exact positions & orientation of new items may be subject to a final site survey and setting out plan.

Any inconsistencies on site should be verified with HAGS before commencement of work.

HAGS recommend that existing trees are risk-assessed by the client to ensure the integrity of accessible branches, that overhanging limbs do not conflict with new play equipment or vehicle access and that the canopy will not produce excessive leaf drop which could cause a hazard within the play area.

This design layout conforms to the relevant EN Safety Standard.

GRASS & GRASS MAT SURFACING

Where equipment is installed directly into grass and the free height of fall is between 0.6m and 1.5m it is the responsibility of the playground operator to ensure that the grass sward is maintained in good
