I wish to oppose the above application for development of BP Sports Field.

Having been a resident of Sully in close proximity to the site for over forty five years, as a growing family we have enjoyed all the benefits and attributes of this wonderful open space.

From bird watching, kite flying and various ball games, and have enjoyed observing many of the football matches over the years and the fear of this being put

in jeopardy with 200 dwellings in appallor!

If this application is approved, the impact on traffic flow through the Village would be enormous, with Smithies Avenue in particular, used as a rat-run and an essential route to the already over-subscribed Primary School in Burnham Avenue, becoming an intolerable situation.

Sully is at present served very well by two shops, a Post office + Pharmacy but would suffer greatly if retail outlets were to be placed on the proposed development, especially the smaller one attached to the Post office, where ~~personal service~~ RECEIVED has accounted for so much.
