The above planning Application has been submitted for the following:
Installation of a 12.5m slim line mock telegraph pole supporting 6 no. antennas, 2 no. transmission dishes, 2 no. equipment cabinets and ancillary developments.

I understand that this is a prior notification for a permitted development and the visual impact will be considered in the decision. It will be positioned on the common land between the end of the footpath from Westward Rise and the cliff top fence line.

I object to the proposal for the following reasons:

- 1 The site is adjacent to a Marine Conservation Area, SSSI, Marine Protection Area.
- 2 The mast will be directly sited outside residents homes and in a highly prominent and visually beautiful area that forms part of Welsh Coastal Path.
- 3 A potentially significant threat to health.
- 4 Increased noise levels.
- 5 Potential harmful effect on local wildlife.
- 6 Area of local archaeological importance.
