PROPOSED BASE STATION INSTALLATION AT CTIL_208045, TEF_50807, VF_12837, DINAS POWYS SERVICE STATION, CARDIFF ROAD, DINAS POWYS, SOUTH GLAMORGAN, CF64 4JS (NGR: 315630/171273)

This application is submitted under Part 24 of Schedule 2 to the Town And Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995, as amended by the Town And Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (Amendment) (Wales) Order 2002 and the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (Amendment) (Wales) (No. 2 Order) 2014 and in accordance with the electronic communications code under the Telecommunications Act 1984 Schedule 2 as amended by the Communications Act 2003.

This is an application for a determination as to whether the prior approval of the Authority will be required to the siting and appearance of the development.

Telefónica UK Limited has entered into an agreement with Vodafone Limited pursuant to which the two companies plan to jointly operate and manage a single network grid across the UK. These arrangements will be overseen by Cornerstone Telecommunications Infrastructure Ltd (CTIL) which is a joint venture company owned by Telefónica UK Limited and Vodafone Limited.

This agreement allows both organisations to:

- pool their basic network infrastructure, while running two, independent, nationwide networks
- maximise opportunities to consolidate the number of base stations
- significantly reduce the environmental impact of network development

This application is submitted for and on behalf of CTIL and Telefónica UK Ltd and comprises:

- Written description of the proposed development: *Installation of a 15m high monopole supporting 3no. shrouded antennas, 1no. 300mm diameter dish antenna, 2no. equipment cabinets and ancillary works* At Dinas Powys Service Station, Cardiff Road, Dinas Powys, South Glamorgan, CF64 4JS (NGR: 315630/171273), defined within the plan indicating its location, numbered 100B
- Prescribed fee £380 in a cheque made out to the local planning authority
- Copy of Developer's Notice, and proof of delivery
- Confirmation the site is not within 3km of an airfield
- ICNIRP declaration

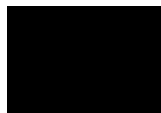
