Hi Douglas,

I have received a formal response from National Resource Wales in respect to application. There were a couple of matters I raised with NRW that were being raised within the representations to get their view/observations on the issues that have been raised by the public. These issues included

- The size of the water tank and whether it was sufficient for the plant and permit
- The proposed drainage system and an issue raised over climate change
- Dust particle and management plan- an objector has noted that there is a discrepancy between the
 waste codes referenced in the Dust and Particulate Emission Management Plan (DPEMP)
 compared to those set out in the permit

As you can see from the comments from NRW, they have indicated that the fire tank is not required as part of the permit. While this does not raise any objection from NRW as it is not required as part of the fire prevention plan your planning statement indicates that it is necessary in order to gain consent for the permit. Could you provide me with a response as to why the water tanks are necessary as part of the development if it is not required as part of the Fire prevention Plan?

With respect to the dust management plan, NRW have confirmed that there are waste codes that have been removed from the permit that remain stated in DPEMP, can you amend the document to ensure that it correlates with the permit waste codes?
