Thank you for the breakdown details of the traffic movements, I have passed these onto the highways section.

I attach an extension of time for the determination of the application. I did send a letter in the post last week that requested a shorter period of extension but if you could ignore that correspondence and accept the attached as request for extension of determination. It has also been noted that the attached site layout plan (Annex 3 attached) does not include the entirety of the extended site edged red and conflicts with the site edged red submitted on the site location plan (Annex1). As such, could you amend Annex 3 plan to remove the red line boundary (as it is not needed on this plan) and to increase the size of the extended area (car parking no. 9) to accord with the application site extension.
