In your previous comments you did outline that Welsh water offer no comments on the application to vary conditions 5 and 19 subject to maintaining drainage related conditions on any new consent granted for the development, namely conditions 13, 14, & 27. But indicate that you may want to comment further if the application is altered.

I wanted to make you aware that in view of the application being a variation of the original permission, details of the sustainable drainage conditions attached to the original permission (2015/00031/OUT) have now been included with the application for consideration rather than conditioning the details again.
