PREAMBLE

Asbri Planning Ltd has been appointed by Austin-Smith: Lord on behalf of the Welsh Government to co-ordinate the Environmental Statement (ES) as part of the outline application for residential development and associated infrastructure works and community facilities on land at Upper Cosmeston Farm, Lavernock Road, Penarth. The application is an outline application and was validated on the 14th October 2020 and was accompanied by an Environmental Statement. The Planning Application reference number is 2020/01170/OUT.

The document entitled 'Addendum to the Environmental Statement' (thereafter the Addendum) relates to the whole application site presenting additional information requested from internal and external consultees in respect of the planning application.

This addendum does not replace the submitted ES but is intended to be read alongside that document in order to deal with the specific points highlighted by consultees. In some instances where there are fundamental changes to the chapter they have been replaced.
