To whom it may concern / Helen Jones,

Further to our initial appeal application (**REF: APP/26950/A/15/3018505**), we have made additional investigation and state that there are a few points further we would like to address.

From our home, there are numerous other skylights to be seen all around us. Please see attached **photographs 1, 2 and 3** which are visible from where I was sat in the back garden. From the front of the house, we see the Skylights pictured in **pictures 1, 2 and 3**. There are skylights to be seen on the majority of houses in our street (**pictures 4, 5, 11 and 12**) and within the immediate vicinity further along Stanwell Rd (**pictures 6, 8, 9 and 10**)

In addition, **pictures 5 and 12** are of the same house which is four doors down from ours. The skylights seen on the house are higher than ours, protruding higher than ours.

Likewise, there are dormer conversions of all different shapes and sizes to be seen in our immediate location, **Picture 11** shows a dormer conversion which looks very similar to ours, located further along on Stanwell Rd. The **bottom three pictures** show other dormer conversions which are on Railway Terrace, which is in very close proximity to our home.

We do not feel that our dormer conversion is overpowering or out of context; it does not stand above the existing skylights to be seen from other properties on the street.

It does not stand above the ridge line and does not project higher than any of our neighbouring properties.
