The two entries for Old Leckwith Bridge reflect the fact that the bridge spans two separate community areas but they are in fact the same bridge. This is confirmed in the list description for 26487 which states "See Record Number 13748 in Canton (Cardiff) community for full description of this bridge."

Notwithstanding the above, I note that in the dataset that Cadw have provided Ref 26487 is shown on the modern bridge. I have asked Cadw to investigate this and to make the appropriate amendments.
