Information in the Historic Environment Record does not note any archaeological features or artefacts within the redline boundary itself. Historic mapping sequences from the early 19th century onwards note quarrying activity in the vicinity.

Given our understanding of the nature of a potential archaeological resource, and the proposed development, it is our opinion that it is unlikely that any significant archaeological remains would be encountered during the course of the development.
