We, David and Alison Thomson of Little Hamston Farm, Duffryn, strongly oppose the planned route of the new Five Mile Lane.

Having studied the proposals online, we are aware that the plan is to re-route the road through our fields adjoining the existing Five Mile Lane. Being a relatively small farm this will have severe detrimental effects on our business.

Our daughter, Amy Thomson, also has concerns for her business, AJT Equestrian, which she operates through the farm as well. Again, a relatively small, start up enterprise, funded by the Creative Rural Community, that will suffer greatly should the plans go ahead.


