Thank you for consulting us about this application; consequently we have consulted the detailed information contained on your website.

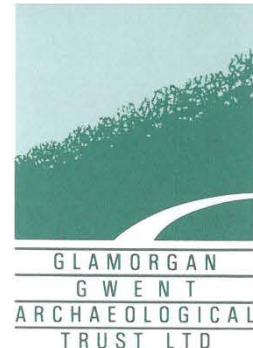
