St. Nicholas Church in Wales Primary School, St. Nicholas, Cardiff CF83 8ER.

A Preliminary Ecological Appraisal to BREEAM standard, as well as a follow-up survey for bats were carried out on this site by AECOM in 2019. Having carried out a walkover visit to the site on 15th November 2021, it is deemed that the original survey report Version 1.6 with the project reference number 60607807, written and reviewed in 2019, is still an accurate representation of the site.

Habitats present on site are still as assessed in 2019, with buildings and amenity grassland dominating the site. The semi-improved grassland at the north-western end of the site has been mown relatively intensively and can also now largely be described as amenity grassland. The grass mound has been removed. Poison has been used along the fence lines.

Buildings on site were assessed as still holding the same amount of potential for roosting bats as previously raised, no additional features of value were noted by this walkover survey. The pond on site still contains invasive species and the rabbit warren along the western fence line is still present.

Discrete changes to the habitats across the site were noted as detailed above, but not to any scale of concern. Please see below some example photographs taken in November 2021. No other changes have occurred, and the recommendations of the report therefore remain the same.
